



Havant Borough Council award GeODC EDCP Project

Havant Borough Council have awarded the Development Services Electronic Data Capture Project (EDCP) to GeODC to computerise over 35 years of Planning and Land Charge data.

The contract includes the scanning of paper and microfiche documents and the capture of textual and GIS data relating to over 62,000 Planning Applications in the borough of Havant.

The overall aim of the EDCP is to transform Development Services in a way which will improve access to data, resulting in the delivery of streamlined services.

One of the primary aims for this project is to produce comprehensive electronic Land Charges, Planning and Enforcement Registers, in order to meet Government targets and provide opportunities for self-service to customers. The need therefore, to ensure that the captured data integrates fully with the existing business application systems, is paramount.

The Authority utilise the CADCORP Geographic Information System, the Plantech ACOLAID back office system and the MERIDO Electronic Document Records Management System so securing a supplier who understood the software and requirements of these service providers was fundamental to a successful project.
